Race Series & Trophies

RISK STATEMENT

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, competitors agree and acknowledge that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission:
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve competitors of their responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat must be appropriately insured and display a Harbour plaque.

BOATS AND COMPETITORS IN DIFFICULTY

When the race committee considers that a boat or competitor is in difficulty it may instruct the boat or competitor to accept outside help, retire or sail ashore. Competitors shall obey such instructions from boats acting as patrol boats. Where a competitor racing observes a competitor in distress or in the water away from their boat and patrol boat cover has yet to arrive it is accepted practice for the competitor to stop racing and stand by until a) patrol boat cover arrives or b) the distress has been resolved. The race officer will give the appropriate redress to the competitor in their finishing result.

Trophy Series (early and late)

Two series of races with separate class starts as listed below:

National Solo

Single handed trophy (early) Fortune trophy (late)

Handicap

Jack Lewis trophy (early) Farwell trophy (late)

Helmsman Series (early and late)

Two series of handicap races run throughout the year: for the most regular but not necessarily the front of the fleet racers)

- Palmer Goblet trophy (early)
- Fred Taylor trophy (late)
- Sagues trophy (Upside Down Series)

 a different scoring system applied
 to the Helmsman series to give a prize opportunity
- Mary Ross trophy (highest placed lady helm in the two Helmsman series combined)

Evening Series

A series of races taking place in the evenings, often on weekdays: Victor Cook trophy.

Junior Race Series

A series of races for juniors:

President's trophy

Longmore Series

A handicap series consisting of one longer course each day: Williams trophy.

May Mini Series

A short series of races held over the Spring Bank Holiday weekend: Sam Burke trophy.

Other Races (and trophies – where applicable)

Harbour Race

A long distance race taking place in the harbour: Bransbury Williams trophy.

Harding Long Distance

A long distance race starting at DQSC, sailing out of Chichester Harbour into the Bay, or in the lower reaches of the Harbour if conditions are extreme, before finishing at East Head: Hitch trophy.

Up the Creeks

A long distance race taking in as many creeks as possible: Horace Gordon trophy.

Bass Cup Series

The annual competition between CYC and DQSC, this year hosted by DQSC, includes juniors: Bass Cup trophy.

Breakfast Breeze

A series of races for early risers: Early Riser trophy.

Noyce/Herbert Ward

Two handicap races held at the end of the summer sailing season: Noyce Memorial trophy (for a helm who has already won a race during this year's programme). Herbert Ward trophy (for a helm who has not won a race during this year's programme).

Longmore Series

A handicap series consisting of one longer course each day: Williams trophy

Pursuit Series

A series of races with classes starting at intervals determined by their handicap numbers, slowest first: Market Cross salver.

Frostbite Series

An open series over the winter season. (Please note that due to major work planned in the club building in 2019, dates for the Frostbite series have come forward into January.)

Optimist Open

National Solo Open Meeting

An open meeting with three races held back-to-back.

Crews/Beginners and All the Rest Race A one-off race for crews and less experienced helms. A good opportunity to 'have a go at racing': Handicap trophy.

Short Races

Five short races held on each of two days including juniors: Carriage Clock trophy.
